52 - HUGH FARTHING MEMORIAL TVS	<p style="text-align: center;">2 ITEMS!</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • I do not speak, yet names I show, From forty-one my roots do grow. • You can find the second item beside the first one! 	
*152 - ALBERTA-NWT COMMAND	<p style="text-align: center;">2 Items</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • I do not burn, yet once held flame, Passed with pride in a global game. Carried by one both brave and true, Who served her country, through and through. • Head outside Command and take a look, You won't need more than a careful look. Near the flags, just steps away, A plaque honours those who served—past and today. 	
264 - NORTH CALGARY	<p style="text-align: center;">2 Items inside the Branch</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Commemorative shovel that dug the first shovel of dirt in the Branch's parking lot. • I can be found in the west windows of the lounge. 	
285 - CENTENNIAL	Not metal, but wood is what I'm made, On a plane, my role was played.	
289 - MILLENNIUM	Stand where the soldier's silhouette meets three poppies.	
288 - AIRDRIE	A unique plaque hangs as a testament to a lifetime of service. It features the very items used by a lady, who was the true heartbeat of The Red Deer and Airdrie Branch for over forty years.	
71 - HIGH RIVER	Three in shadowed black reside, Where mountain walls and rivers collide.

*3 - THREE SISTERS (CANMORE)	A beautiful mural that was installed in 2023. Another clue? It's "Between the Poppies"	
*4 - GENERAL STEWART (LETHBRIDGE)	* Come to the canteen, and you will find me—a tribute to Brigadier-General John Smith Stewart - the gentleman after whom the branch is named.	
*19 - BELLEVUE	A wall of service, proud and true. Their stories wait to speak to you.	
*21 - VULCAN	A Jade cairn in a Diamond shape. Engraved on the left side is the soldier in mourning, representing the First World War – the Past. The engraving in the centre is of an atomic blast representing World War 2 – the Present. On the right is a rocket ship representing the Future.	
63 - E.I.D BROOKS	On the ground I rest, but I travel the clouds!	
160 - BARONS	In the park where memories stand tall, Find the leaf of red that honours them all. Two poppies bloom in metal bright, Guarding words of gratitude and sacrifice. What monument have you found?	
170 - CARDSTON	I once took flight, now grounded I stay. A piece of an aircraft, no longer in play. Donated on Remembrance Day's date—1953 will help you locate	
179 - HEART MOUNTAIN EXSHAW	A stone with words to remember, When poppies bloom, they gather together	
273 - COALHURST	A member's gift for all to view. A cannon stands with two figures— Find this piece to guide you through.

51 - JOE WYNNE (EDSON)	FIND ME! 	
56 - HOLDEN	2 Items! <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Built in 1923 and can be found at the intersection of 50 Street and 50 Avenue in Holden. Go to the Branch side where west winds blow, A painting waits with ocean's flow. 	
59 - STETTLER	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Look for the artwork by 4 students that stays in place, A memory painted for all to embrace. 	
66 - PONOKA	Look for the painted wall that tells the story of the Canadian Armed Forces' bravery and glory.	
91 - TOFIELD	Found in the entrance of the Branch that was installed in the spring of last year.	
105 - OLDS	My name was selected by a Grade 4 from Ecole Olds Elementary school, and I was dedicated to honour the 44 local soldiers who gave their lives for our freedom.	
126 - MAYERTHORPE	A moment frozen, time displayed— The day the Branch first opened, stayed.	
192 - RYLEY	The Branch received this from Command to congratulate them for their continuous service to our Veterans and the community.	
212 - SYLVAN LAKE	The Banner that honours Canadian Armed Forces members who gave their lives during an operations in Afghanistan.	
269 - DRAYTON VALLEY	Found across the street from the Branch.

	GREATER EDMONTON AREA BRANCHES	
27 - FORT SASKATCHEWAN	Painted by M.R. Armstrong and completed in 1997. This is a representation of WW II with features portrait of past Legion members, as well as other service members.	
176 - MORINVILLE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> A mural tribute to all three arms of service during WWII. It is found in the Branch accessible to everyone during normal business hours. 	
226 - GIBBONS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Hanging from the ceiling of the Branch above the Branch's mural. You will find a model design to fly as a radio-controlled aircraft, and it is of an impressive size. 	
255 - JASPER PLACE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> A rare glimpse donated by Comrade Robert that can be found at the old Griesbach. 	
256 - STONY PLAIN	Step outside the Branch and head north—there you'll find a tribute painted in colour, where generations of service are remembered, from historic battles to modern missions	
281 - SPRUCE GROVE	He was a WWI Veteran and a Branch Comrade. Part of the Branch is dedicated in his memory.
